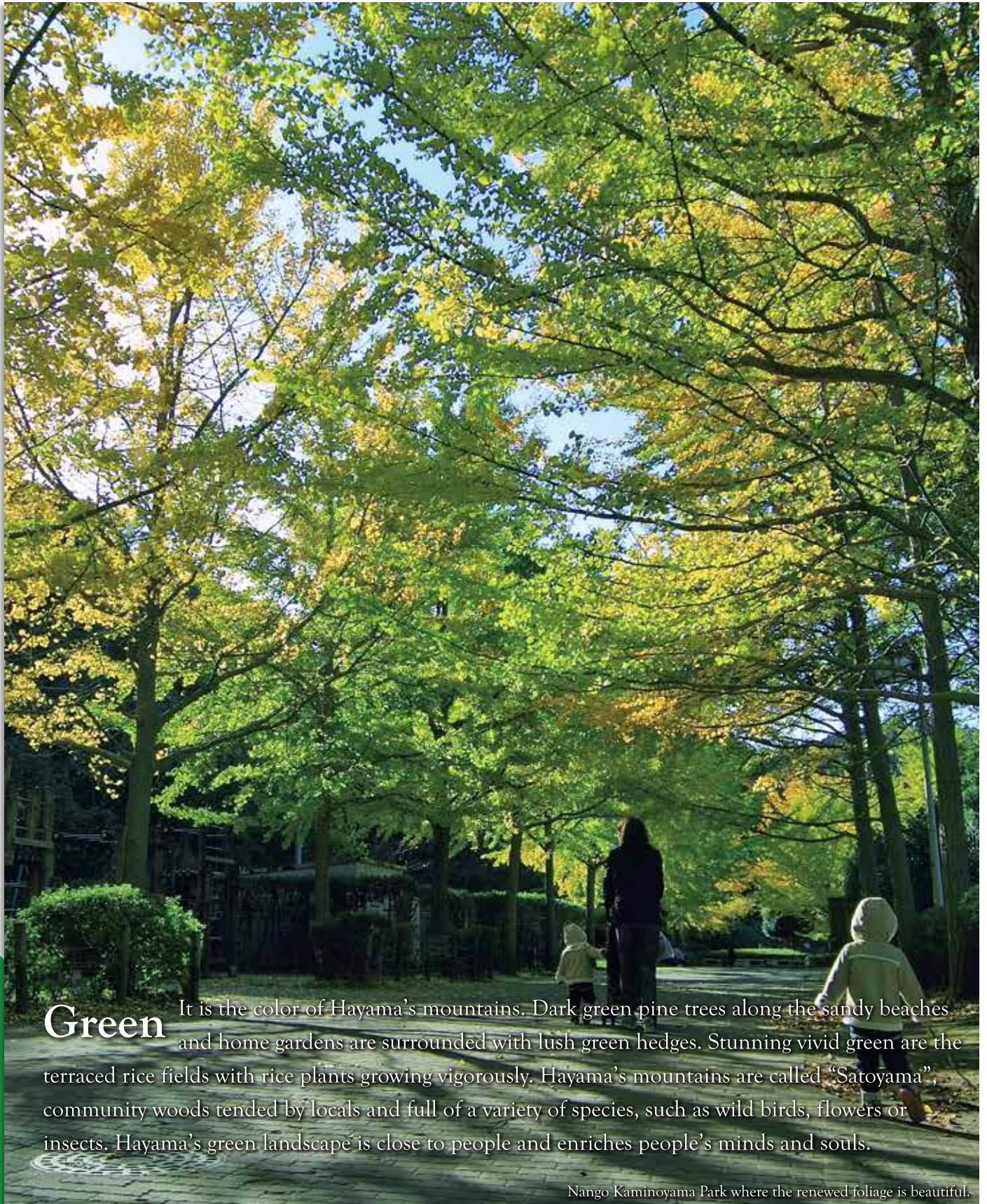


LANDSCAPE × GREEN

Indulge in the Landscape

Terraced rice fields in Kamiyamaguchi were chosen as one of Japan's Top 100 countryside landscapes and represent Hayama's "Satoyama", traditional rural landscape. Go on hiking trails in Sengen Mountain or Sangaoka Mountain with wild birds or take a walk to see vivid red or pink azaleas in Hananoki Park and colorful hydrangeas in Ajisai Park.
