


## When you are in trouble (how to make emergency calls)

You can ask for help by simply pointing out the following sentences to a Japanese local if you wish to make an emergency call.

#### **★Ambulance Call: 119 (Fire Station)**

①I'm ill. Please call an ambulance. 「病気で具合が悪いので、 救急車を呼んでください。」 ②I'm injured, Please call an ambulance, 「けがをしたので、 救急車を呼んでください。」

#### **★Theft/Crime/Traffic Accident, Call: 110 (Police)**

①I've been robbed. Please call the police. 「盗難にあいました。 警察を呼んでください。」

②I've been in a traffic accident. Please call the police. 「交通事故です。 警察を呼んでください。」
