Hayama is known as the town of the Imperial Villa. Hayama Imperial Villa was built in 1894. Around the same time, a lot of villas were built in Hayama to house the Imperial Families, nobles, politicians, business leaders and bureaucrats. Some villas remain as private houses and a religious house to remind people of the old days. Villas of the Imperial Families used to be along Isshiki Beach and now Hayama Shiosai Park and the Museum of Modern Art, Hayama are there as places where you can enjoy art and culture.
